

Ossi Connectors A/S declaration and confirmation of TSCA free products.



Declaration and confirmation

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has published a new rule under Section 6 of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) on Feb. 5, 2021, that 5 PBT substances will be banned in products in the U.S. in the short term.

One of the substances is PIP(3:1) [phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1); other names: Tris (4-isopropylphenyl) phosphate; CAS: 68937-41-7] that will be also banned for use in products in the USA from 08.03.2021.

This substance can be used as a flame retardant in PVC, EPDM, PC/ABS, flexible PU, TPU, PC, mPPO / mPPE, epoxy resins, printing inks and rubber.

This document hereby serves as a declaration and confirmation that none of the above substances are present in the products produced by Ossi Connectors A/S.
